Post and Rope Removal

We have started removing some of the permanent post and ropes around the greens and some fairways. This will help speed up play and allow the maintenance crew to a better job cutting the ruff and fairways. One of the most noticeable changes is on hole #7 where you can now drive on the fairway up to the creek, then you must get back on the path. When exiting the cart path, it is always best to vary your exit so that you're not driving where everyone else has driven. This will limit compaction and keep the grass good and healthy in most areas. As always, we appreciate you following the course signs, arrows and cart policies. It does make a difference.
