Let's Hit the Ground Running It is officially Spring and we can expect better weather and bigger Senior Scramble crowds. It is important that we get off to a positive start with our pace of play on Monday and Tuesday mornings. Please arrive at least 30 minutes in advance of the start time so you have plenty of time to load your clubs on a cart, pay your greens/cart fees, be assigned a start hole, pay your CTP/Skins fees, and enjoy your coffee and donuts before leaving the clubhouse. Whether you are an "A" group or a "B" group, make sure you leave the Pro Shop in time so you arrive at your starting tee at least 5 minutes in advance of the start time. If you are an "A" group, have a ball teed up and waiting so that you can begin teeing off promptly at the start time. If you are a "B" group, have a ball teed up so that you are ready to hit as soon as the "A" group has cleared the landing area. After leaving a green, move quickly to the next tee and prepare to play. Don't lose time recording scores at the green or delaying to observe "honors". If you don't have at least a "momentary wait" for the group in front of you to play, increase your pace of play so that you do have at least a "momentary wait". Let's get off to a good pace of play start on Mondays and Tuesdays this Spring!
