Competitive Season is Almost Here!

When you have played recently in the Senior Scramble or otherwise, you've probably notice that red, yellow, and white stakes are popping up all over the course. This is an indication that the "competitive championship golf season" is fast approaching. We bring in the red and yellow stakes at the end of each season to repaint them and put them out on the course again in the spring so they are in place for competitive events and for league and general play as well. Most of the white stakes are left out all year, since most of them mark private property lines that we don't want to relocate each season. Bear Creek will host an adult competitive event on Saturday, April 16th and three high school competitions during the week of April 25-29. We'll address these competitions, the course markings, and the Rules of Golf in future weeks. For now, refresh your memory on how the Rules of Golf can assist you when your ball crosses a line of red, yellow, or white stakes or comes to rest beyond a line of stakes. We'll test your knowledge in future editions of the Senior Scramble Newsletter.
