Out-of-Bounds

The white stakes you see in certain areas on the course denote the boundary for out-of-bounds (OB). Unlike lateral hazards and water hazards, which carry 5 and 3 options for the player respectively, there is only one option if your ball crosses and OB boundary and comes to rest out-of-bounds. That option is to take a one stroke penalty and play a shot from the same location/conditions as the shot that came to rest OB was played from. So if you teed off on a hole and struck your tee shot so that it came to rest out of bounds, you would replace your ball in the same location and if you put your next shot in play, you would be lying 3, preparing to hit your fourth shot.
