## Water Hazards and Lateral Water Hazards

Last week we discussed areas that are marked out-of-bounds (white stakes). This week we will begin to address water hazards, whose boundaries are marked with yellow stakes, and a special type of water hazard called a lateral water hazard, whose boundaries are marked with red stakes. In common usage of golf terms, a "water hazard" and a "lateral water hazard" are used to describe 2 distinct type of areas on the golf course, and in future discussion I will use the words as they are used in common usage. By technical definition in the Rules of Golf, all lateral water hazards are water hazards, but all not all water hazards are lateral water hazards. We will further address the relationship of these 2 terms in future editions.
