Fall Course Recovery

As the cooler weather begins, the golf course is well underway with its fall recovery. We have aerated and seeded the tees and have sodded some tee and ruff areas due to heavy traffic. We recently performed a new aerification process which includes a deep 14 inch drill (1/2 inch in diameter) green aerification on holes #3, #4, and #6. This will relieve compaction and allow the greens to breath. We will aerify all the greens in October with an 8" tine and fill with sand. The heat and severe heavy rains made it very difficult for most courses in this area. Bear Creek faired very well all considering. We want to thank everyone for their patience as we continue preparing the course for the 2017 season.
