## Off Season News

We all think we've seen everything, heard everything, felt everything and even hit everything but I don't think this February's weather has been experienced by any of us. Just when I was happy to get 1 to 2 good weather days this month we now will have almost 10 warm days in a row. The golf course grass is still dormant, yet we've cut greens 3 times this week to keep them smooth, cut tees on Friday, spun and fluffed the bunkers, moved tee blocks and rotated the pins to fresh cups. Our winter projects are well underway and some are very obvious on the course. Hole #9/#10, hole #6/#7 have tree limbs waiting to be put in the chipper. We have over 5000 foot of new wired pulled underground to sprinkler heads, some heads are still needing to be hooked up. Our pump station has the well shaft to the Jockey pump pulled out and in for repair, a large 6 foot pipe has been welded and retrofitted to replace the leaking pipe in the pump station as has yet to be put in. It's been so dry that most of the courses are wanting to turn on their irrigation system only to have it snowed on and possibly frozen in March, hmmm. Our largest project of all is the installation of material bins down at the maintenance shed. That project is almost 75% complete. All the golf cart batteries were filled with water today which is usually done once a month in season, not this year. So, let's keep playing in the senior scrambles, we have great weather and lots to play for.
