Rule on Bunker Play

The rules made simple on Bunkers is that they are a hazard and played just like regular water hazards (Yellow Stakes) and lateral water hazards (Red Stakes). So when you select to play a ball out of the hazard you must play it as it lies, the 2nd person should take a drop as close as possible to spot where the first ball lies. If your ball lies in casual water you can take free relief but the ball must be dropped in the hazard. The only time you would ever get a free drop out of the bunker is if the entire bunker was full of water and this will very seldom happen. If you are playing with someone who thinks differently, please have them play 2 balls, one in the bunker and one out of the bunker and the Bear Creek Golf Professional will help you with the ruling when you get in.
