## Zoysia Tee and Fairways

The zoysia grass on most of the regular senior tees is starting to finally come in. February and March were extremely warm so the zoysia turned green earlier in April so we were excited. Once the heavy April and May rains came with cooler temperatures we noticed the zoysia just stopped growing, turned yellowish and started to retreat. We pulled the play of the senior tees, aerated most of them, fertilized all of them to make them healthy and speed up their growth. This has helped a lot but speeding up mother nature will just take time. Once the warm temperatures set in you will see the pop in the zoysia grass which will make the ball sit up for your shot, less moisture on top of the grass and a little less roll side to side to keep you in the fairway.
