Pace of Play

The senior scramble pace of play has been good this year. In general, the more up front your group is in the starting order the faster you will play simply because there's less people on the course ahead of you. Most of the seniors have found a comfortable spot in which allows them to show up at the time they desired and play at a comfortable pace. Here are some tips that have helped over the years.

Load your clubs with your partner on any cart. Pay in the pro shop, pick up winnings if you have some from previous weeks. Take receipt and check in to get assigned starting hole. Enjoy coffee and donut. Head out to your holes 10 minutes before tee off. Group A be on the tee ready to hit. Group B should be at tee, parked and ready.

If there are a few things you see that you could improve on please do. Let's all help keep the pace moving. Staying 1/2 hole from the group in front of you at all times is our goal.
