## Flex Golf Shaft

What flex golf shaft are you playing? There are a lot of us that are playing with clubs we've played with for years. As we get older our swing speeds have dropped therefore our shafts are too heavy and too stiff. The ball reacts by lowering trajectory, less distance, less spin resulting in a dead feeling at impact. We all are trained to just try harder. Well, that doesn't work because your body can only swing so fast based on your strength and flexibility so we end up in a rut year after year. So, lets all take a good look at our shafts, most of us should be playing regular or senior flex shafts and have made the switch over to graphite shafts which are lighter and can be made more flexible. We do not have a swing speed machine here at Bear Creek but please visit a local golf big box store and have your swing speed tested. Once you know your swing speed they will then tell you what flex, weight, kick point, steel or graphite to get. If you buy new clubs or change clubs where the shafts fit you the difference will be well worth the time. Your game will start improving versus staying the same or getting worse.
