Starting Hole

I have a lot of conversation as to which hole the players like to start on. Some like to start on a par 4 or par 5 so they can be a little reckless with their first drive and warm up as they play the longer holes. A few like to start on a par 3 so they don't have to swing so hard starting out of the gate or they feel their best shots come out first and it's all downhill from there. Some like to be on the first or second hole so they're in front of the pack, maybe play a little faster, or finish near the clubhouse. Some like to be an A group and be first off, some like to be B group and be second off. A groups mean you tee off quicker, B groups get to relax with not having the pressure of another foursome watch them tee off. Whatever your thought process is, just remember, you get to play all of them so it's fair for everyone. Try mixing it up sometimes and see if it really makes a difference in your score.
